

Spanish NTI Lesson 3

Obj. To review conjugating verbs/To write a paragraph describing someone in your family

Part 1. Spanish verbs in the infinitive form end in -er, -ar- or -ir. To conjugate a verb in the present tense, you need to drop the -er, -ir or -ar and add the ending that goes with that verb ending.

Endings for an -ar verb

-o	-amos
-as	-áis
-a	-an

Endings for an -er verb

-o	-emos
-es	-éis
-e	-en

Endings for an -ir verb

-o	-imos
-es	ís
-e	-en

Example: Caminar (to walk)

Since the last two letters of this verb are -ar, I need to use the endings for an -ar verb. Drop the -ar and add the endings for an -ar verb.

Camino	Caminamos
Caminas	Camináis
Camina	caminan

Conjugate the following verbs:

1. Comer (to eat)
2. Mirar (to watch)
3. Beber (to drink)
4. Escribir (to write)
5. Hablar (to talk)
6. Cocinar (to cook)
7. Leer (to read)
8. Descansar (to rest)
9. Compartir (to share)
10. Vivir (to live)
