CREDENTIAL PATHWAY

Access to online **Child Development Associate** (CDA®) courses and financial assistance to complete credential.

INCENTIVES

- 100% tuition and textbooks for CDA
- \$500 in office supplies
- \$350 barrier reduction stipend
- \$200 completion stipend
- Lakeshore Learning Materials

HIGHER EDUCATION PATHWAY

Financial assistance to pursue a **bachelor's or** associate degree in child development or related field from an accredited college or university.

INCENTIVES

- Up to \$2,300 for AA and \$5,500 for BA in tuition support per semester
- \$500 in office supplies
- \$550 barrier reduction stipend annually
- Lakeshore Learning Materials

- 3. Agree to complete the Early Care and Education Empowerment Toolkit (ECEET), a 12-hour course
